

Important Information Regarding Your Property New Assessment Roll 2026-2027-2028

Dear Sir or Madam,

On January 1, 2026, the new property assessment roll for your municipality will come into effect. As you will see, property values in the MRC of Brome-Missisquoi have experienced a significant increase, reflecting the recent trends in the real estate market (see table on the reverse side).

We understand that a substantial increase in your property value may raise many questions.

How is your property's value determined?

The MRC's assessment department conducts rigorous and impartial work in accordance with the **Act respecting municipal taxation**. Our mandate is to establish the actual value of each property, which corresponds to 100% of its market value. To do so, our assessors consider:

- Analysis of the real estate market in recent years;
- Characteristics specific to each sector of the municipality;
- The particularities of your property observed during assessment visits, which may affect its value;

This is not a simple indexation but rather a reassessment considering all the components of your property.

Key points to remember:

- Your property value was established based on the market value as of July 1, 2024;
- This value will remain the same for the next three years (2026-2027-2028), except in the case of renovations or additions;
- The municipal council does not intervene in the assessment process.

You can request a review by following these steps :


1. Complete the designated form, available online : <https://www.mrcbm.qc.ca/en/request-for-review>

3. Follow the detailed procedure on the reverse side of your tax bill.




