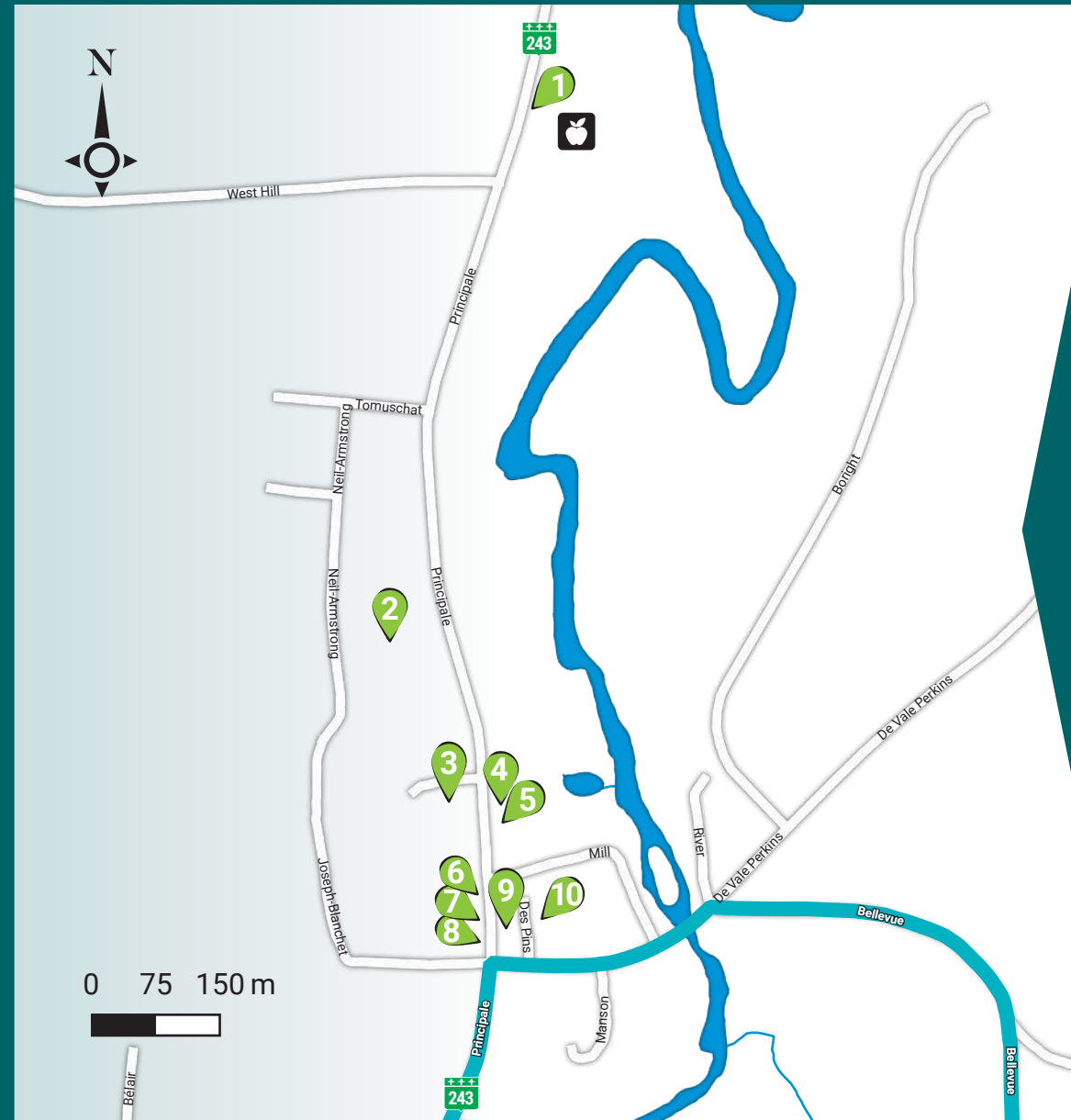

Take an unforgettable stroll through Mansonville, the hub of Potton Township. Discover the Round Barn and various other heritage buildings. In summer, the town takes on a festive air, with a public market on Saturdays, concerts every Sunday and a range of other popular cultural activities. When the weather turns cold, winter sports take center stage amid magnificent snow-filled vistas.

In addition to the omnipresent Sutton Mountains, six other major peaks overlook Mansonville: Owl's Head, Bear Mountain, Hawk Mountain, Mount Elephant, Sugar Loaf Mountain, Mount Pevee and Hog's Back. The municipality's Appalachian landscape alternates between mountains, forests, meadows, lakes, ponds, streams and rivers. It's a true hiker's paradise!

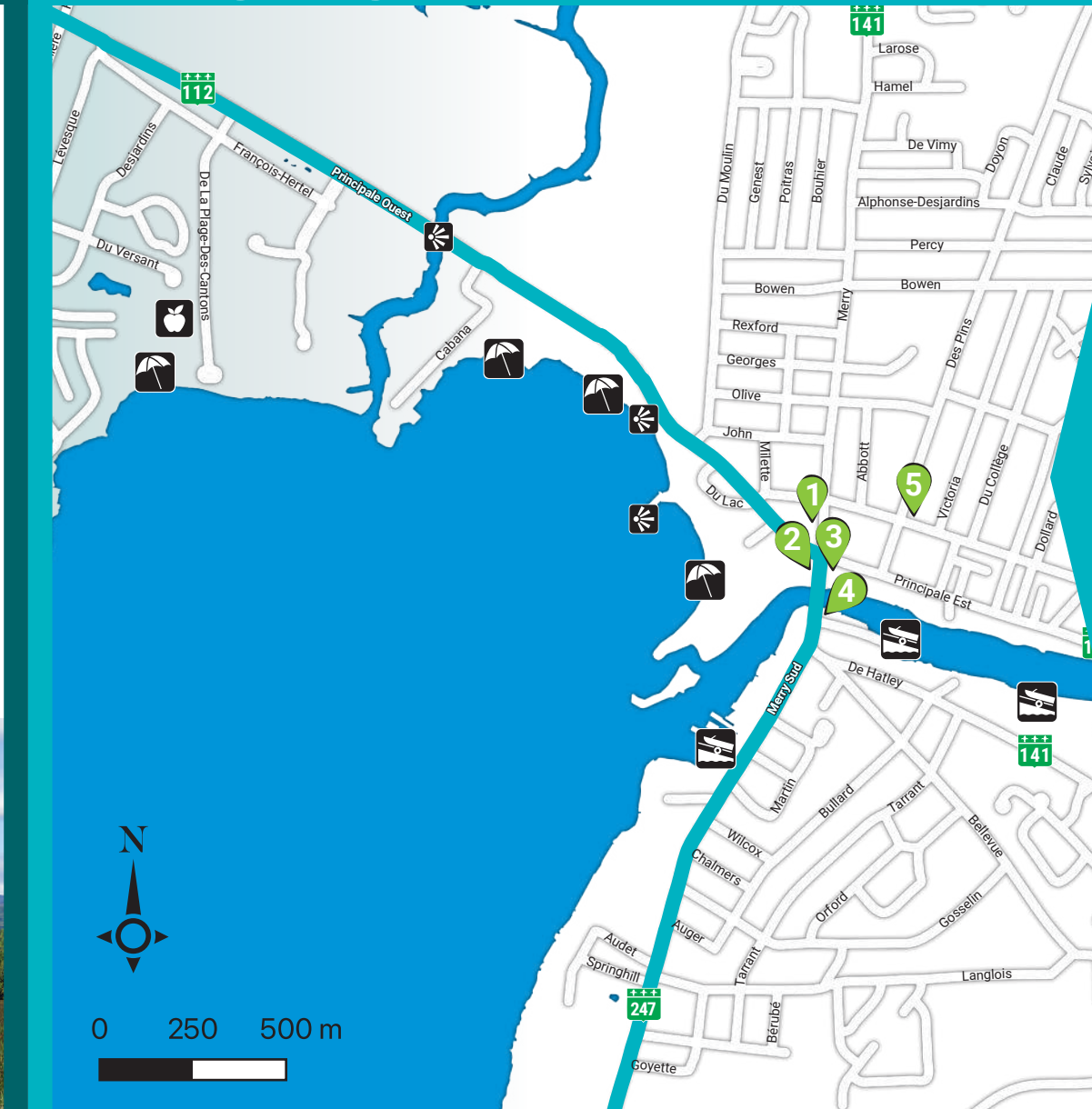

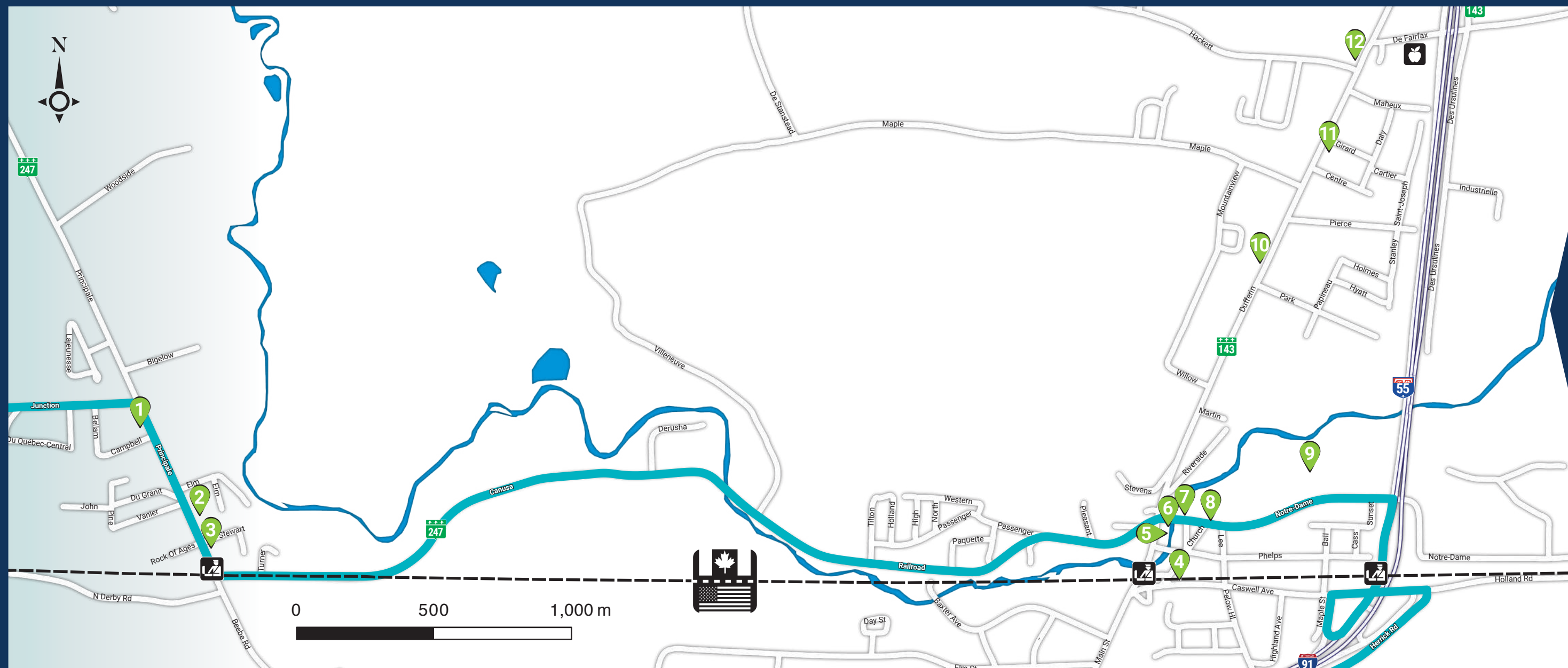

A Cross-Border Adventure Around the Lake



Stanstead



The Canada-U.S. border divides the Québec town of Stanstead from the village of Derby Line in Vermont. Stanstead was created in 1995, through the amalgamation of three villages: Beebe, Rock Island and Stanstead Plain.

Proud of its rich history and folk legends, Stanstead is known as the granite capital of Canada. Local stone, which continues to be mined and processed, has been used in buildings the world over—including the famous Abbey of Saint-Benoît-du-Lac.

Newport



Founded in 1793, the Vermont city of Newport is located on the southern shore of Lake Memphremagog. The community's history has been shaped by its unique lakeside location and the arrival of the railroad.

Newport's earliest businesses were tied to the timber industry and lake-based activities. The city is known for its picturesque scenery and tourist appeal. Various historic structures have been converted into stores, restaurants and public buildings.
